Vineyard:

Machado Creek Vineyard is a beautiful landscape tucked into the eastern side of the Santa Cruz Mountains. Just outside Gilroy tucked into the hillside, which allows for long even ripening of my Rhone Varietals. The soil is red clay loam and has been fed over time by the creek that runs through the middle of the vineyard. This 10 acre vineyard is where we get our Petite Sirah, Grenache, Mourvedre, and Sangiovese. This vineyard is the heart of Odonata's wines representing 70% of production.

Winemaking:

Picked at: 24 Brix, 3.5 ph , 5.8 tons

Whole Berry destemmed

Pumped over, and then gently punched down for 14 days

Aged 23 months in 30% new French oak Barrels, 70% neutral oak

Finished wine:

Bottled August 3rd, 2016

Unfiltered, Un-fined

14.2% Alc. By volume

3.7 ph

-- This particular wine is the heart and soul of Odonata! The dark ruby/purple color sets the tempo for this wine. On the nose you'll be met with inky dark fruits, herbs and spices. The palate is perfectly driven by balance, with opulent fruit, tannin and graphite. This Petite is special now, but with time has the potential to become something extraordinary.
